Faculty Expertise—Faculty are selected primarily for their teaching ability and their proven ability to relate to experienced managers. Selection to teach in the MBA Program is considered a mark of distinction. Tenure and rank are not considered.

Washington DC Internship—Through the International Executive MBA, students will participate in a week long educational trip to Washington DC.
